Donated by the Womack family and dedicated in memory of the late Milton J. Womack, Sr., the Serenity Garden is located near the Small Animal Clinic entrance of the Veterinary Teaching Hospital. Landscaped by LSU landscape architect students, it provides a peaceful spot for reflection.

The Serenity Garden is a place to honor special family members or pets with an engraved brick that will be viewed by the many visitors and clients who come to the LSU School of Veterinary Medicine.

### Serenity Garden Sculpture

A beautiful bronze water sculpture, showing the affection of a girl with her cat and dog, is being created as the centerpiece of the Serenity Garden. This one-of-a-kind artwork, designed by sculptor Meg White, will be installed in spring 2008.
