Registration

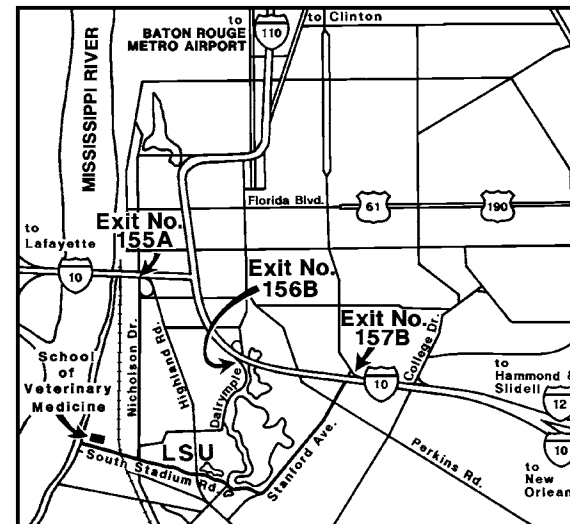
Registration fee is \$125 before November 19 (\$150 after November 19). Fee includes seminar materials, break refreshments, and a catered lunch.
