Dr. Nicole Northrup is a 1994 graduate of Cornell University College of Veterinary Medicine. She completed a rotating internship at the Animal Medical Center in New York, N.Y., and a residency in medical oncology at Tufts University School of Veterinary Medicine. In 2000, Dr. Northrup started the oncology program at the University of Georgia College of Veterinary Medicine, where she had the pleasure of working with LSU's own Dr. Tracy Gieger. The UGA program has since grown to four oncologists and three residents. Dr. Northrup is currently a Chief of Staff in the Department of Small Animal Medicine and Surgery at UGA. Her interests include clinical trials of new treatments for veterinary cancer patients and improving diagnostic techniques in veterinary oncology.

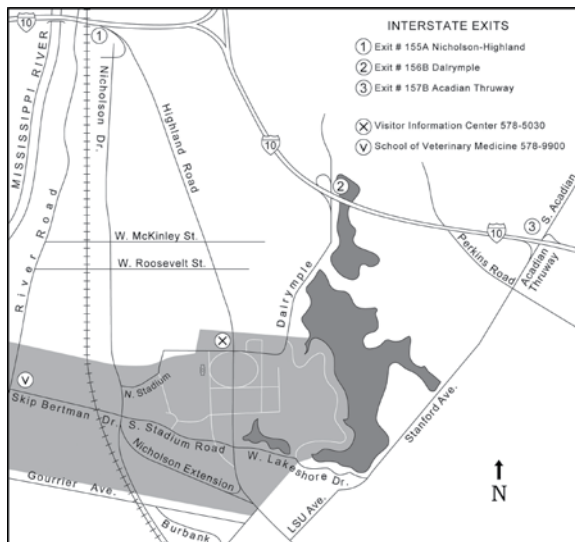
### Cancellations
