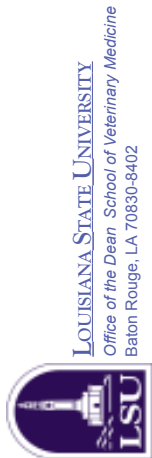

RULES OF ENTRY

Theme: Animals in Art

Juror & Judge: Ann Connelly, artist and gallery owner, Baton Rouge, LA

Awards: \$1000.00 Best of Show award, as well as other cash awards. One entry will be chosen to appear on the cover of the *Journal of the American Veterinary Medical Association*.

Eligibility: Open to all artists 18 years of age or older. All media. Works must be original. Any work that is determined not to meet the spirit of the exhibit will not be accepted. All artwork must be priced and for sale.

Entries: Slides or digital images on disk (JPG or TIF) only. Selection of works to be accepted in the exhibition will be chosen from 2" x 2" mounted 35 mm slides or on disk in JPG or TIF format. Only 1 slide or digital image should be submitted for each 2-dimensional work. A maximum of 3 slides or digital images may be submitted for 3-dimensional work. Each slide or disk must be labeled with name, title, and medium; each slide must be labeled to indicate the top of the artwork. Maximum size of entry is 60"x60"x48". Any accepted artwork that differs from the slide or digital image will be disqualified.

Fees: A non-refundable fee of \$10.00 for each entry must accompany the entry form. A check or money order should be made payable to **Louisiana State University** with the notation "**Animals in Art Entry**" in the memo line .

Sales: All work submitted must be priced and for sale. A 15% commission will be taken on all sales.
